

**PROCESS FOR ACCEPTING ROADS
INTO THE PARISH ROAD SYSTEM**

ROAD MAINTENANCE MANUAL

AMENDMENT NO. 5

Accepted by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury: November 2, 2009

The following revision is to be made to the Road Maintenance Manual, adopted by the Vermilion Parish Police Jury on January 19, 1981, as amended on March 5, 1984, to the Section – *Minimum Requirements for Accepting Roads Into the Parish Road System*.

1. All roads – A minimum right-of-way of fifty (50) feet. On dead end roads, a fifty (50) foot radius turnaround shall be provided.
2. All roads – A minimum road bed of twenty-eight (28) feet together with proper drainage constructed to acceptable engineering standards. On dead end roads, a forty (40) foot radius turnaround shall be provided.
3. All roads – A minimum roadway width of eighteen (18) feet constructed of limestone (grade approved by VPPJ) or approved equivalent, surface material compacted to a minimum depth of four (4) inches. Dead end roadways shall have a thirty-five (35) foot radius turnaround constructed to the same requirements as the roadway.
4. All dead end roads without a cul-de-sac shall provide a T-turn with a depth of thirty (30) feet and a width of sixty (60) feet. The T-turn shall be thirty-five (35) feet from the end of the designated right-of-way.

2. Submit three (3) road names to the Vermilion Parish Communications District 911 Office (337-898-4350).
3. Once a road name has been determined, contact your Police Juror.
4. Police Juror will have the Parish Road Supervisor inspect road.
5. If all specifications are met, the Police Juror will present the road for approval and accept the road into the Parish Road System.
