AMENDMENT NO. 1

A STATE OF EMERGENCY ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF "NO WAKE ZONE" IN ALL OF VERMILION PARISH ON ALL WATERWAYS AND ROADWAYS WHERE WAKE COULD CAUSE DAMAGE TO PRIVATE PROPERTY AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATIVE TO HURRICANE IKE.

BE IT ORDAINED by a State of Emergency by the President of the Vermilion Parish Police Jury.

SECTION 1: NO WAKE ZONES

All Waterways and Roadways in Vermilion Parish flooded due to Hurricane Ike, are hereby designated as no wake zones. No motor vehicle or watercraft shall be operated at such a speed that would create or cause a wake that could possibly cause damage to the property of others.

SECTION 2: PENALTY

Any person violating any of the provisions aforesated shall upon conviction be fined not less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) nor more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00) or imprisoned for not more than thirty (30) days or both.

SECTION 3: DECLARATION

If any word, clause, phrase, section or other portion of this ordinance shall be declared null, void, invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, the remainder of said ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: IMPLEMENTATION

This ordinance is adopted due to a State of Emergency relative to Hurricane Ike.
