(A) Coastal Protection & Restoration Committee

AS A RESULT OF A COASTAL PROTECTION & RESTORATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON MAY 04, 2022, THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE RESPECTFULLY SUBMITTED FOR THE JURY'S CONSIDERATION:

It is recommended to authorize for the president to sign a contract with Sellers & Associates for the Administrative consultant services on the Vermilion River Bridge Debris Barrier System Project as well as execute the Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the State and any other necessary documents.
2. It is recommended to authorize sending the Sellers and Associates survey crew to take measurements of the breach and to prepare permit drawings and plans for repair as well as to receive quotes for the repair efforts at the Water Control Structure near Schooner Bayou.
